## MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES

### ASSOCIATE

Associate membership shall consist of retirees and individuals employed part-time in the parks and recreation field and individuals not principally employed in the field who are interested in the Association's objectives and services and the advancement of parks and recreation.

Membership Benefits: Associate membership includes section affiliation and MPRA publications. Your listing will be included in the MPRA Membership Directory and Buyers Guide. You will receive registration discounts for MPRA events.

### STUDENT

Student membership shall consist of students. Anyone meeting the criteria for professional membership shall be ineligible for student membership. Any student enrolled in a Missouri college or university whose parks and recreation department is an organizational member of MPRA may choose to deduct 20 percent from his/her student membership fee.

Membership Benefits: Student membership includes section affiliation and MPRA publications. Your listing will be included in the MPRA Membership Directory and Buyers Guide. You will receive registration discounts for MPRA events.

### PROFESSIONAL— Working for MPRA Public Agency Member

Professional membership for individuals employed full-time by a parks and recreation agency or organization that is a group member of MPRA. The organization/public agency group membership application and fee must accompany or precede your individual professional membership application.

Membership Benefits: Professional staff membership includes the right to vote, hold office, section affiliation, and MPRA publications. Your listing will be included in the MPRA Membership Directory and Buyers Guide. You will receive registration discounts for MPRA events.

### PROFESSIONAL— NOT working for MPRA Public Agency Member

1. Individuals engaged full-time in the delivery of professional parks, recreation, and leisure services.
2. Individuals with a bachelor's degree in parks, recreation, and leisure services from an accredited university and five years of full-time employment in the field of parks, recreation and leisure but not currently employed full-time in the field.
3. Individuals with ten years of continuous full-time employment in the field of parks, recreation, and leisure services, but not currently employed full-time in the field

Membership Benefits: Professional membership includes the right to vote, hold office, section affiliation, and MPRA publications. Your listing will be included in the MPRA Membership Directory and Buyers Guide. You will receive registration discounts for MPRA events.

#### Renewal Deadlines

##### IMPORTANT NEW INFORMATION: PLEASE READ

All memberships expire December 31. A grace period through January 31 will be extended. Anyone not renewing by January 31 will be removed from membership rosters and will not receive member benefits or communication, including critical conference information and member discounts.

New members joining MPRA from January through September will be charged 100 percent of fees. Anyone joining after October 1 will receive membership through December 31 of the following year.

#### Paperless Policy

In an effort to reduce paper waste and increase staff productivity, MPRA encourages membership and event registration be completed online. Paper registrations will continue to be accepted but will be charged a \$10 processing fee.

You can register for membership or any event online and select the "Pay by Check" option if your organization requires. Please remit payment AND the invoice to MPRA to complete your registration.
